<u>English – Communication (Speaking and listening)</u>	
<u>Monday</u>	<p>During Literacy the children will be looking at different pobble 365 pictures related to the topic. Please talk to your child about these pictures, describe what they see and ask and answer questions to gain more information. This week the picture is https://www.pobble365.com/friends-for-life/</p>  <p>What do you notice? <i>Parents – please take turns with your child to say what you notice in the picture</i> <i>Resources – Pobble picture</i></p>
<u>Tuesday</u>	<p>How do you think the gorilla and the man are feeling? Where are they? Say “I can see _____” using the CIP words</p> <p><i>Resources – Pobble picture, I can see bubble and Concept in Print pictures (CIP)</i></p>
<u>Wednesday</u>	<p>What is in front of them? What was the mighty beast’s reaction?</p> <p><i>Resources – Pobble picture</i></p>
<u>Thursday</u>	<p>What do you think they are looking at? Is it something happy or something sad? Draw what they might be able to see.</p> <p><i>Resources – Pictures of jungle animals/ settings</i></p>
<u>Friday</u>	<p>Describe your drawing “The man is sitting with the gorilla ” “They are sitting in the jungle”</p> <p><i>Resources – Pictures of jungle animals/ settings</i></p>
<u>Spelling/ phonics</u>	
<u>Monday</u>	<p>Please use the phoneme mat provided to recap the sounds that your child recognises. Take turns with your child to say and find different sounds. Touch the letter Aa and say “a”.</p> <p><i>Resources – Phoneme mat (alphabet)</i></p>
<u>Tuesday</u>	<p>Look at the individual letters, say the sound selected and find/match to the phoneme mat. Say the sound</p> <p><i>Resources – Phoneme mat (alphabet) / individual letters</i></p>
<u>Wednesday</u>	<p>Play find the ____ game. Place some of the letters out and say “find me the ____”, child collects the selected sound</p> <p><i>Resources – Individual letters</i></p>

Thursday	<p>Use the sounds m / a / s / d / t / i / n / p / g / o / c / k / u / b / f / e / l / h / sh / r / j / v / y / w /</p> <p>Sound out / m / a / p / map. Child to make / m / a / p / map</p> <p><i>Resources – words –</i> - red/ run/ rat/ jog/ jet/ jam/ vet/ yap/ yes/ yum/ web/ win/ wish/ wet/ sock/ jug/ key/ well/ ship/ shop/ fish/ rag/ rip/ job/ van/ yak/ yet/ wig/</p>
Friday	<p>Say the words for your child to make Map, sat, pin, got, mit, mop, Child will listen, say the sounds in order and make the word</p> <p><i>Resources – words, individual letters</i></p>

Writing	
Monday	<p>Teach Handwriting  Do 5 exercises daily</p> <p>- https://teachhandwriting.co.uk/handwriting-warm-up-exercises.html</p> <p>Please practice your child's full name so that all the letters are formed correctly. Please use the RWI (alphabet) sheet provided in your home learning pack. Say the letter formation as you write the letter eg. "round the apple and down the leaf" when writing the letter /a/. Say the letter and sound of the letters in your child's name. Form the letter correctly.</p> <p><i>Resources – RWI letter formation sheet, child's name card</i></p>
Tuesday	<p>Say a letter and sound. Child to form the letter correctly. Practice writing all the letters of the alphabet. Say the letter name and sound.</p> <p><i>Resources – RWI letter formation sheet</i></p>
Wednesday	<p>Use the words from spelling for your child to write. Say the word eg. map, show on your fingers the sounds /m/a/p/, say word again – map</p> <p><i>Resources – words to write – map, tin etc</i></p>
Thursday	<p>Using the drawing of your jungle setting, look at the CIP words and write on your picture to describe it – gorilla, man, sitting, jungle</p> <p><i>Resources – CIP words</i></p>
Friday	<p>Write sentences to describe your jungle picture "The gorilla is sitting with the man" "They are looking at the jungle "</p> <p><i>Resources – CIP words to support ideas</i></p>

Monday	<p>Please continue reading the books that have been sent home. Please share your child's reading book. Please talk about the pictures and what is happening in the story. Encourage your child to read each word</p> <p><i>Resources – reading books</i></p>
Tuesday	<p>Please listen, share and ask questions about the reading books sent home. Talk about who is in the story? What is happening? What do they think will happen next? Look at the initial letters and read the text in the book</p>
Wednesday	<p>Bugclub - Please log in and read the books that have been selected for your child at their level of learning - Username and Password given</p> <p><i>Resources – https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login?c=0</i></p>

Maths	
Monday	<p>Order the numbers 1-10. Remove a number and find the missing number. Find 1 more than and 1 less than. Use numbers 1-20 when confident with 1-10</p> <p><i>Resources – individual numeral and number lines</i></p>
Tuesday	<p>Practice writing numerals to 10 and numerals 1-20 Say a number, child finds on the number line and writes and says the numeral Repeat with other numbers</p> <p><i>Resources – number lines</i></p>
Wednesday	<p>Collect 5 different objects in your house. Put them in order of their height. Say which object is the shortest object and which is the tallest.</p> <p><i>Resources – objects to measure</i></p>
Thursday	<p>Look at the objects from yesterday. Select the tallest item. Use a ruler to measure how tall the object is</p> <p><i>Resources – objects to measure, ruler</i></p>
Friday	<p>Look at the numerals. Say the numerals in order. Mix them up and say the numeral. Select a number and count out the correct amounts</p> <p><i>Resources – Number lines, individual numerals</i></p>
	<p>Please continue to practically count out amounts of objects. Look at the numerals 1-20 and count out the correct amount of objects. Extend by adding and subtracting numbers up to 10 – I have 10 sweets and give 5 to my mum, I have 5 left.</p> <p><i>Resources – Number lines, individual numerals ,</i></p>
