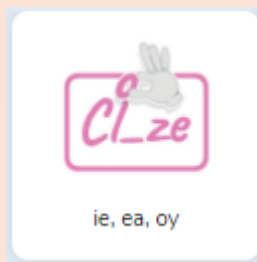

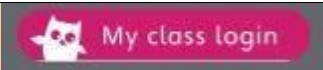
Practice your phonic sounds using the purple mash 2do's set.

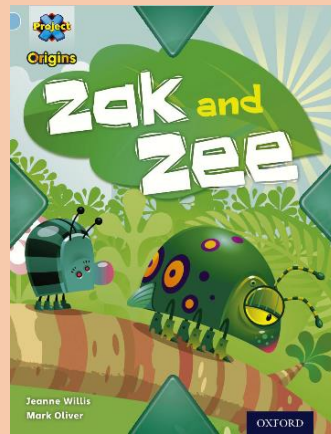
