Thank you to all the parents who attended our Parent forum on Thursday afternoon, it was lovely to see you all and we value your feedback. During the meeting we discussed the outcomes from the parent survey and our next steps which included: increasing parents' awareness of what children will learn during the year; working together to improve attendance and increasing parental involvement. Parents had fantastic ideas to share on how to increase parent/school communication and raise attendance. There was also the concern raised around parking outside of school. Parking on school 'keep-clear zigzags' is **dangerous and illegal**. They are there to protect the safety of your children. **Vehicles that park on school keep-clear zigzags can obstruct the vision of children, making it dangerous when they are crossing the road.** You can also be issued a penalty charge notice from enforcement officers patrolling the area.
