

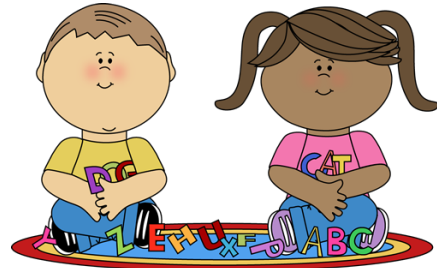


In Literacy

This term the children will be reading lots of exciting stories such as: Goldilocks and the three bears, **We're going on a bear hunt, Biscuit Bear, The Tiger Who Came to Tea, and The Jolly Christmas Postman.** They will be acting out the stories using puppets and masks. We will be doing lots of cooking linked to the stories and tasting lots of new food.

How you can help at home....

- *Read to your child EVERY DAY, make sure they hear different stories and enjoy favourite ones regularly so they can re-tell them on their own.
- *Share a book with them EVERY DAY and talk about the different things happening in the pictures.



In Maths

The children count everyday to check how many children are in Nursery. We sing lots of number songs such as, 1,2,3,4,5, 5 Little Speckled Frogs, 5 Currant Buns.



We will be using different words to describe the size of objects such as big, little, and middle sized. We will be counting and classifying bugs and insects. We will be beginning to count and recognise numbers to 10.

How you can help at home....

- *When you are at home or walking around town or driving in the car get your child to count different things, such as how many red cars they can see or get 5 spoons for the dinner table.
- *Look at objects in the house and talk about the shape of them.
- *Look at numbers on front doors, in supermarkets, on buses.

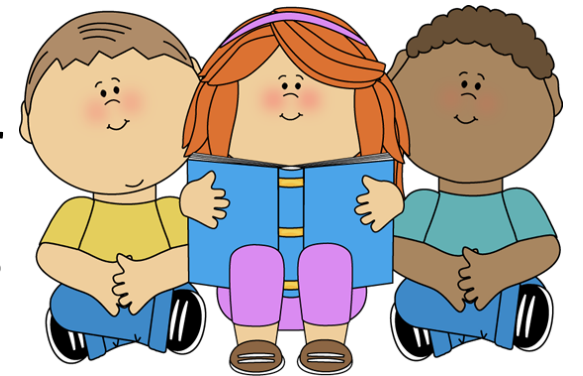


We will also be doing some baking and tasting different fruits and vegetables.
