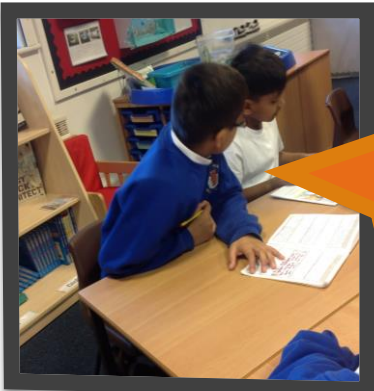
We acted out the role of the SS Officer and the commandant in a concentration camp.



I enjoyed sharing my retell with Year 4.



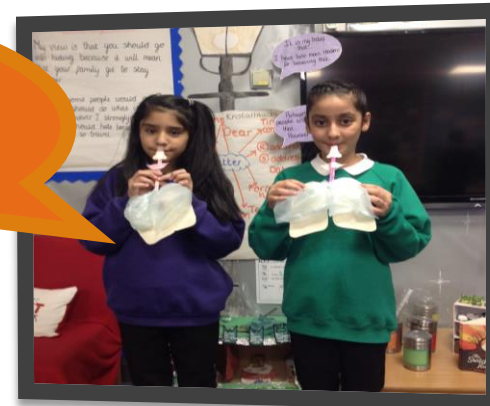
Class 14 loved raising money for Children in Need.
