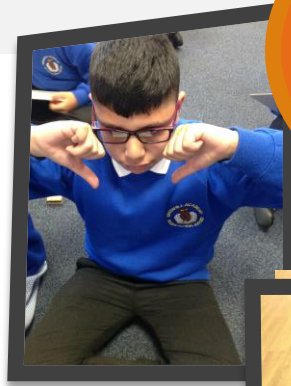


# Autumn 1 in Class 13 Year 6

I enjoyed raising money by doing a Music treasure hunt

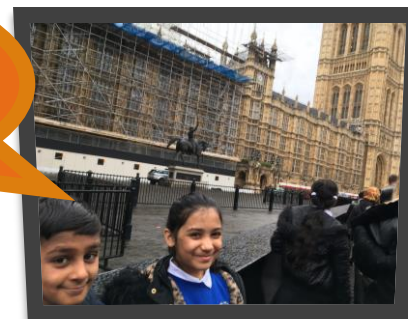
We got to go on the Millennium eye.
