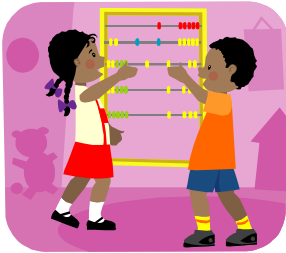


## In Literacy

In Literacy this half term the children will be reading a range of books around the topic of refugees. We are going to be reading *The Arrival*, *The Island*, *Journey* and *My name is not Refugee*. The children will be writing a range of genres such as: persuasive letters, narratives and diary entries.

### How you can help at home....

Support your child with their big write/extended write homework that they get weekly so that when they do their big write/extended write on a Friday they will be as prepared as they can be. Ask your child about the book they are reading in English and question them about the characters and the plot.



## In Numeracy

The children are continuing to learn maths in a variety of ways. We are going to be doing a lot of work on reasoning and problem solving, ready for our Sats. As well as this, we are going to be practicing our arithmetic skills weekly.

### How you can help at home....

- Help your child practice their multiplications. Your child now has a TT Rockstars account where they can practice their multiplications that have been set for them. It is very important that they meet their deadlines on this.
- Support your child with their weekly I AM LEARNING and CGP homework.
