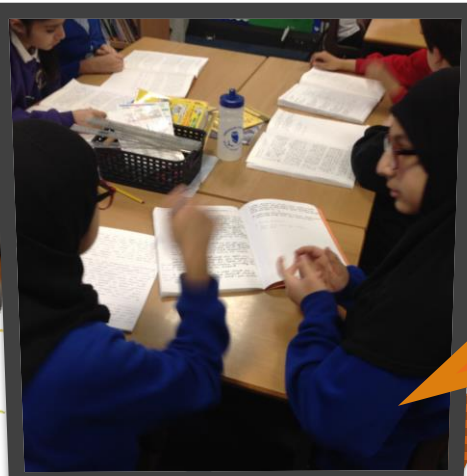


Spring 1 in Class 14 Year 6

Class 14 love doing Accelerator Reading. We enjoy spending 20 minutes each day reading our book and quizzing.

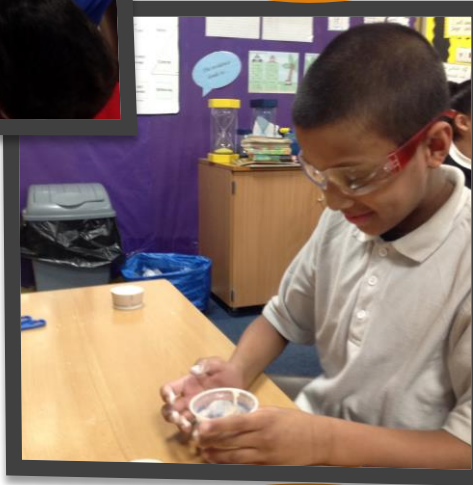


We have worked collaboratively with our peers in maths to help solve challenging reasoning questions.
