Update regarding the closure of one provision bubble

Further to our message on Friday 19th June regarding a person in one of our bubbles showing symptoms of Coronavirus, testing has shown that the **person has tested positive for Covid-19.**

All staff and pupils in the bubble have been asked to self-isolate at home for 14 days. The person with symptoms was last in the bubble on Friday 19th June so this bubble will be closed until Monday 6th July. Siblings of children in this bubble do not need to self-isolate unless their sibling begins to show symptoms.

Everybody in the affected bubble is eligible for a Covid-19 test and we have recommended they undertake this as soon as possible.

The rooms used by the affected bubble have been closed and we are arranging a deep clean.

We have contacted Public Health England and they confirm that all necessary procedures are being followed. Due to the safety measures we have put in place, the risk of bubbles having mixed is low. **Therefore, other bubbles in school can remain open.**

As always we have the safety of our staff, children and our families at the forefront of our minds. Should there be any further information, we will let you know as soon as possible.
