Update regarding the closure of one provision bubble on 23rd June 2020

A person who was attending a newly opened learning bubble at the academy on Tuesday 23rd June has developed a high temperature. They were new to the site today and had not been in a bubble prior to today. They have been advised to self-isolate for a period of 7 days. The person will have a test and should have their results soon.

Our agreed risk assessment states that if anybody in a bubble has any Covid related symptoms that we will close the affected provision bubble. This is above and beyond Government guidance and is being taken as a precautionary measure.

This means that Greenhill Academy will close the affected bubble from Tuesday 23rd June until we receive the results of the test. During this time there will be an enhanced clean of the areas used by this bubble. There will also be additional cleaning across the academy. We are in close contact with those families who are affected.

Other bubbles remain unaffected. If you have a child in provision it is fine for you to send them in unless we contact you directly.

As always we have the safety of our staff, children and our families at the forefront of our minds. We will continue to provide as much information as soon as we can.
