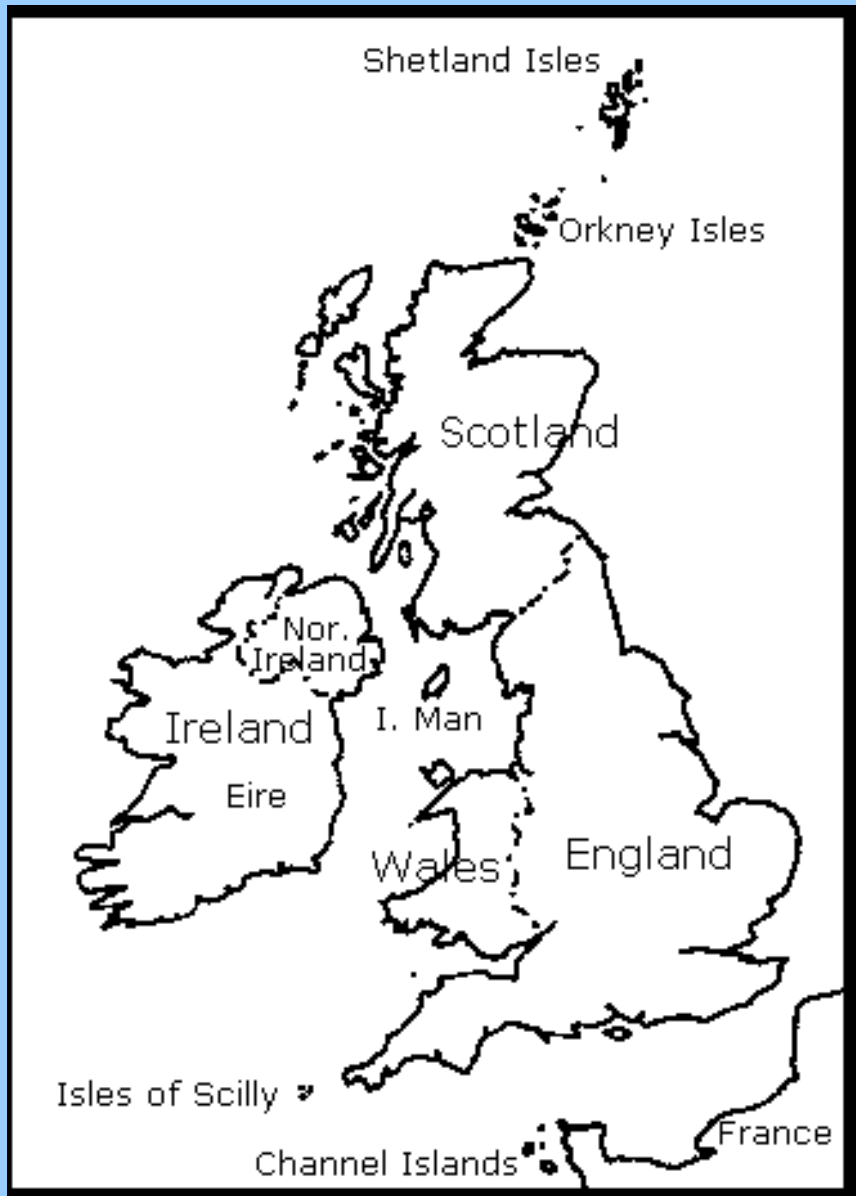


The United Kingdom and The Republic of Ireland

Edinburgh.



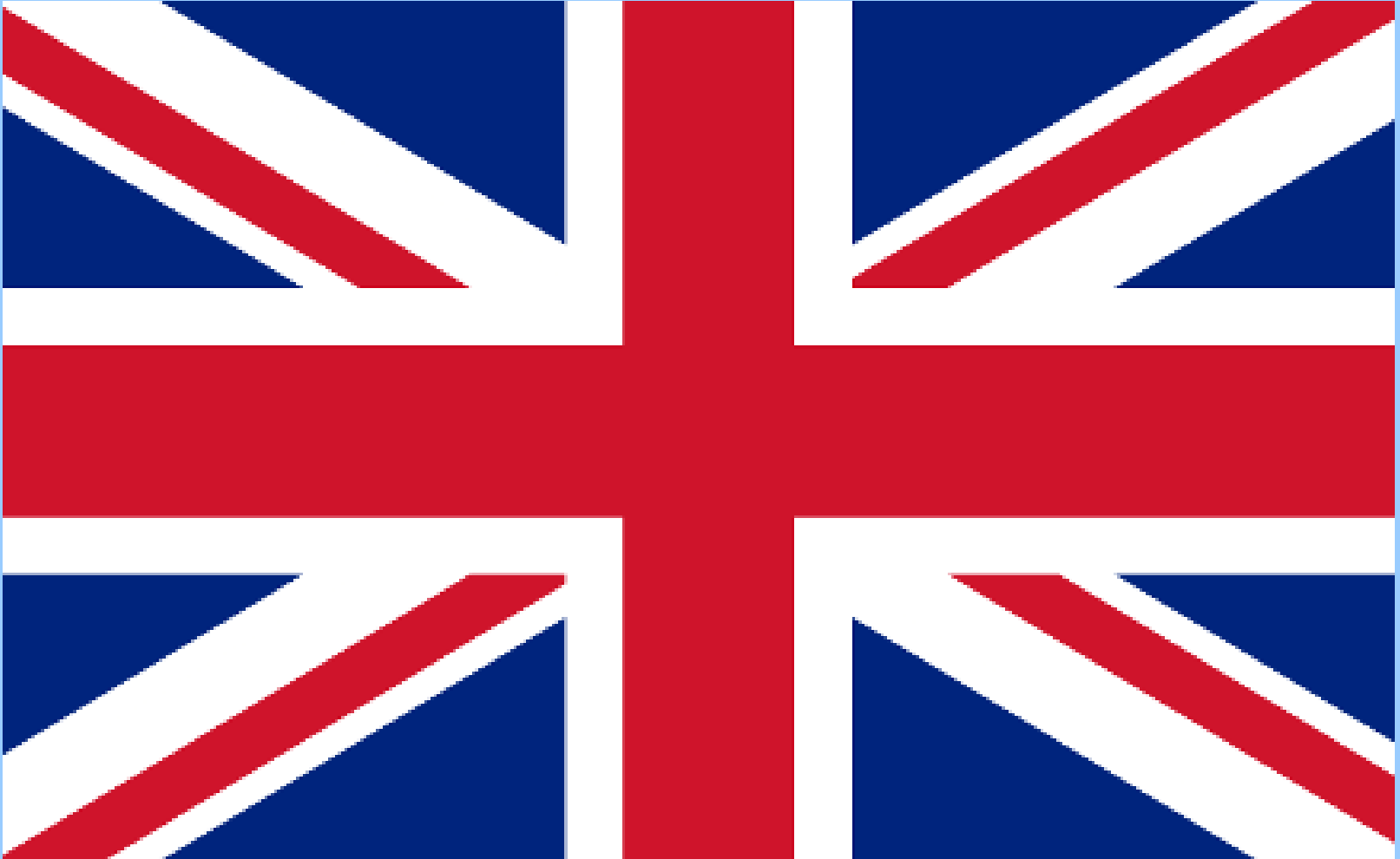
The capital city of Wales is
Cardiff.



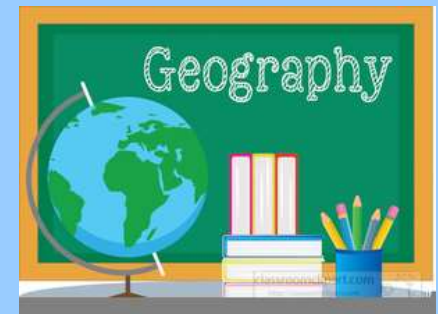
The capital city of England is

British landmarks - England



- **Buckingham Palace**
- When you think of England, you probably think of the Queen and the royal family. Since 1837, the London home of the Queen has been **Buckingham Palace**. This huge building has 775 rooms, including 78 bathrooms. Over 50,000 people a year are invited to the palace as guests, and many more visit it as tourists.
- **Stonehenge:**
- Stonehenge is one of the world's most famous monuments. It stands on **Salisbury Plain**, in Wiltshire, and its giant stones can be seen from miles around.
- **Tower Of London:**
- You will find the Crown Jewels under armed guard in the Jewel House in the Tower of London. They are still worn by the Queen today for important ceremonies.
