## Lesson structure /i/

Say /j/ - Sing and bounce jjjjjjj, push your lips forward as you make the sound - describe the picture before showing the children

- Hold up picture-sound cards in turn, stretch the sound at the start



/j/ jjjj/ jam



/i/ jug



/j/ jigsaw



/j/ jelly

Repeat until children are fluent

# Read /j/

in the box saying jjjjj. Say jack as you touch Jack's head

Write /j/ on the board beside the jack in the box, make the same size. Run finger down the /j/ saying jjjj. Say /j/ as you touch the end of /j/

- show the speed sound card (picture side). Say jack in the box.
- show the letter side. Say /j/ Repeat until children are fluent

<u>Speed sounds</u> Hide /j/ in the middle of the words Show cards m/a/s/d/t/i/n/p/g/o/c/k/u/ b/f/e/l/h/r/ and practice until can read at speed

#### Write /j/

1/.Handwrite. Air write /j/ saying — down his body, curl and dot 2/. Sound write. Say jjjj, in a rhythm as air writing large /j/ Repeat 1/. And 2/. Getting faster each time Repeat 1/. And 2/. On paper

Speed write Choose 3 of the sounds previously taught - m/a/s/d/t/i/n/p/g/o/c/k/u/ b/f/e/l/h/r/sh/ck/ Write the sound said as quick as you can
Fred talk (oral) Say these words in fred talk j/e/t, j/o/b, j/o/g, j/a/m, j/o/p, j/o/f,
- children repeat the fred talk and say the word - j/e/t jet
Use 1 set of m/a/s/d/t/i/n/p/g/o/c/k/u/b/f/e/l/h/r /sh/ck/  Make these words – steps –  Real words – met/ set/ fan/ fun/ fat/ lip/ log/ let/ had/ hit/ hen/ ship/ shop/ fish/ sack  Nonsense words – gof/ shup/ hib/ fot/ gock
Please use the phoneme mat provided to recap the sounds that your child recognises.  Take turns with your child to say and find different sounds.  Touch the letter Aa and say "a".  Resources – Phoneme mat (alphabet)
Look at the individual letters, say the sound selected and find/match to the phoneme mat.  Say the sound  Resources – Phoneme mat (alphabet) / individual letters
Using the individual letters, play find the game. Place some of the letters out and say "find me the", child collects the selected sound Resources – Individual letters
Use the sounds  m/a/s/d/t/i/n/p/g/o/c/k/u/b/f/e/l/h/sh/r/j/v/y/w/  Sound out / m/a/p/map.
